PURPOSE //

OBJECTIVE //

INSTRUCTIONS //

Materials

- Rocks - small and smooth to paint
- Paint pens
- Clear paint sealer (optional)

Application

- Create a rock garden with a sign to encourage students to take what they need
- Leave rocks in random places to brighten someone's day
- Hand out rocks at lunch or arrival/dismissal

Assembly

1. Wash rocks to remove debris
2. Paint a base coat on one side of the rock and let dry
3. Use paint pens to write an inspirational message - see below for ideas!
4. Once dry, use clear paint sealer if desired to preserve paint
